Law: It is under way

Documents required:

1. Application letter from the investor.
2. Two photos.
3. Graduation papers from a university in Kabul or foreign country.
4. National ID card or passport and visa from a foreign investor.

Foreign investors have the same process as Afghan investors, except that a certificate from a foreign university is accepted.

The process takes from one to ten days to complete. Three signatures are required, the final one being that of the Director of the Animal Husbandry and Animal Health Directorate.

Cost (Fee): Free

The license must be renewed each year. Renewal takes an hour. A "Renewed" stamp is placed on the old license; there is no fee.

Step by step process of acquiring the license.

1. The investor submits an application to the General Directorate of Animal Husbandry and Animal Health.
2. This Directorate reviews the application, and gives it to the applicant to take to the Prophylaxis and Treatment Department.
3. This Department asks the applicant for his/her graduation (educational) documents (certificates). The investor must be graduated from a Veterinary Faculty. The Department asks the investor for a photo copy of his/her certificate with two photos.
4. A panel from the Department is then assigned and sent to visit the clinic in order to inspect it.

If everything is acceptable in the panel's report, the investor is issued a license.
